## Film director is Jung at heart

LANCASTER film producer Chee Keong Cheung has signed a major distribution deal for his latest movie, *Where Love Reigns*.

Becker Films International will be handling the worldwide sales of the movie which has Douglas Henshall in the lead role as psychoanalyst Carl Jung.

The tripartite production between the UK, Canada and South Africa features industry giant Martin Scorsese as executive producer.

And legendary cinematographer Jack Cardiff, who lensed *Black Narcissus* and *Sons and Lovers*, will be acting as creative consultant.

The £3 million film is based on the true story of the torrid love affair between one of the founding fathers of modern psychology and his patient Sabina Epierlein.

Classical British actor Simon Callow has been cast as Jung's associate Eugene Bleuler and shooting is scheduled to start in February next year.

Chee, whose family run the Golden Dragon restaurant in George Street, first cut in his teeth in the world of filmmaking while a student at the Lancaster Royal Grammar School.

Since then he has launched a string of increasingly successful productions including *Crashing the Wake* which was recently screened at the Notting Hill Film Festival and which has acquired an Irish distribution deal.
